

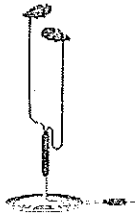
EDGEWOOD SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

2016 - 2017

Dear Parents,

The list of school supplies your child will need for the 2016 – 17 school year is below. Please note the following:

- All K5 – 5th grade students should have a **large backpack**, a **pair of gym shoes** to wear on days they have PE, and a set of **headphones or earbuds** to use with technology. Headphones/earbuds should preferably:
 - Have a microphone as well to use with new technology tools
 - Have a single msb plug-in



- *Starred* items need to be purchased at school.
- Please drop off supplies on Open House Night (August 30th from 4:30-7:30pm). This is particularly important in K4-2nd grades.

Junior Kindergarten Supply List

- 1 – **LARGE**, library book sized backpack (with child's name written inside)
- 2 – Boxes of crayons (16 classic colors only)
- 2- **Thin** dry erase markers (any color)
- 3 – Elmers glue sticks (Elmer's sticks better than other brands)
- 1 – Package unscented baby wipes
- 1 – Art smock with name clearly labeled (an old short-sleeved, adult shirt works best)
- 1 – Change of clothing (**socks, underwear, long pants, and shirt**). Please label each item as well as the bag they are in (a gallon zip lock bag works well).

AM class, please bring:

- 1 – Box of Kleenex
- 1—Package uncoated 10 in. Paper plates
- 1 – 4 pack of play dough

PM class, please bring:

- 1 – pack sandwich ziploc bags
- 1 – large package of napkins
- 1 – pack plain, uncoated small paper plates

** You will need to send one small (**peanut/peanut butter/nut free**) snack with your child on a daily basis. Please do not send water bottles or juice – the room has a water fountain the students are free to use.

All Kindergarten Students

- 1 – Package of baby wipes
- 1—Art Smock
- 1 – Change of clothing (each item labeled and in a bag with your child's first and last name) (socks, underwear, long pants, shorts, long & short sleeve shirt)

Except for items mentioned, supplies should not be individually labeled, as they will be shared. Also, please teach your child to tie their shoes before starting school.

Mrs. Jegier's Kindergarten Students

- 1 – 3 x 3 pack of Post-its, any color
- 2 – White school glue (Elmer's, please, as it sticks the best)
- 20 – Elmer's glue sticks (we go through them fast)
- 2– Packages of Crayola markers (broad tip-classic colors)
- 2 – Dry erase markers
- 1—Box of tissues
- 1 – Pair child-sized scissors
- 2- 1" binder (hardcover) (label)
- 2 - Boxes of Crayola crayons (24 ct.)

Mrs. Lepper's Kindergarten Students

- 1- Elmer's white school glue (It sticks the best!)
- 20 – Elmer's glue sticks (we go through them fast) 1-pair scissors
- 1 – Package Crayola markers (broad tip – classic colors)
- 2 – boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons
- 12 - #2 pencils (sharpened)
- 1 - 5 oz. Box of dixie cups
- 1-package of napkins
- 2- dry erase markers (any color)
- 1—Box of tissues
- 1 – 1" binder (hardcover) with plastic sleeve on front (label on side with name)
 - A-F– bring 1 box sandwich size ziploc baggies G-L – bring 1 pkg. Large paper plates M-Z bring in paper or plastic bowls
 - A healthy snack and juice donation for the class 4 times a year. You do not need to send in a daily snack.

Except for items mentioned, supplies should not be individually labeled, for first grade. They will be shared or labeled at school.

- 2 – Glue sticks
- 2 – Black thin tipped dry erase markers
- 1 – Box of 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 – Highlighter (any color)
- 2 - Containers Clorox disinfecting wipes
- 6 – Plain colored pocket folders (1 red, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 purple, 1 orange)
- 2 – Wide-ruled spiral notebooks (1 green, 1 any color or design)
- 2 – Wide-ruled composition notebooks (any color or design)
